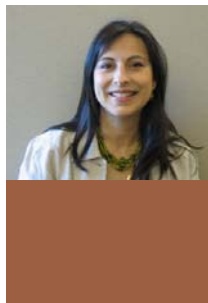


2009 BRINGS CHANGES AND NEW PROJECTS

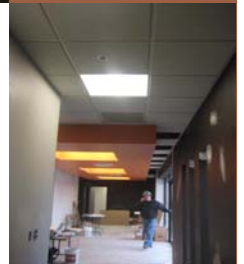


Psychology Departments of both Georgia State University and Georgia Institute of Technology have combined into a collaborative setting for Advanced Brain Imaging and Research, where shared technology, administrative, research, student and faculty offices will be housed in a renovated warehouse/office building on the western edge of the Georgia Institute of Technology campus.

InSight has provided all Architectural Interior Design and Construction Documents and is collaborating with a large team of consultants on this project including Newcomb & Boyd Consulting Engineers for MEP/FP Engineering, KSI Structural Engineering, Doulgerakis Civil Engineering, Siemens (MRI Technologies), ETS Lindgren Shielding, and Georgia Institute of Technology Office of Information Technology (OIT). In addition, Insight Design has provided all Furniture (FF&E) Selections and Specifications. Construction is currently underway by DPR Construction, with Georgia Institute of Technology's Office of Facilities, Design and Construction managing Construction Administration.

Construction completion is scheduled for early Spring 2009.. The MRI is installed and applications are being prepared.
